### >> PENS (DIP, PEN)

Dip Pens (check your local craft store- look for inking or drafting nibs, not calligraphy)  
Japanese Nibs: Tachikawa G Nib, Zebra Nib

### >> PENS(BRUSHES & OTHERS)

Pentel Pocket Brush Pen, Sumi Brushes,  
Bamboo Sketching Pens

### >> MULTILINER PENS

Sakura Pens, Copic Multiliners

### >> ADDITIONAL

Windsor Newton Designer's Gauche (Permanent White), sponges, rubber stamps, manga tones, Lightbox, pencils and erasers, mechanical pencils w/blue lead, French curves, ruler, white-out or correction fluid, airbrush, paper towels
